

## **GAS COMPLIANCE CERTIFICATE QLD**

### **USING A LICENSED GAS FITTER**

Always use a licensed gas fitter. NEVER attempt to do any alterations to any gas fittings or appliances yourself. Unlicensed gas work is illegal and can be extremely dangerous resulting in serious injury or even death. Licensed gas contractors have the equipment and knowledge to do the necessary work safely.

### **WHY DO I NEED A GAS COMPLIANCE CERTIFICATE?**

This certificate informs your LPG supplier that the installation has been completed by a licensed gas fitter and it is therefore safe and legal to supply gas to this location.



**Insurance companies may not cover fire or public liability claims caused by do-it-yourself or unlicensed installations.**

### **WHAT IS A GAS COMPLIANCE CERTIFICATE?**

A Gas Compliance Certificate is an assurance that:

- the gas fitter is appropriately licensed
- the work completed has been tested and is proven to be safe
- the work complies with the requirements of AS 1596 and AS 5601 and other applicable Australian Standards.
- the contractor has officially informed you of any existing safety problems with your installation
- you have met your legal obligation to own a safe installation and have a permanent legal record for the job.

A Gas Compliance Certificate should be given to you within thirty days of completion of the following gas work:

- installing a new gas pipe work
- extending or repairing existing gas pipe work
- installing new appliances – example heaters, hot water units, stove tops
- replacing an appliance.



**If you do not receive a gas compliance certificate this will jeopardise your insurance if a gas-related incident subsequently causes fire or damage to the property. It could also result in you not being able to arrange a supplier to supply gas to your property.**

## WHAT DOES A COMPLIANCE PLATE LOOK LIKE?

A small metal plate with the numbers stamped into the metal.

## WHERE CAN I FIND A COMPLIANCE PLATE?

The plate is fitted inside the premises' electrical meter box and the gas compliance certificate number will be recorded here as well as on the paper certificate that is provided to you.

## WHAT DOES A GAS COMPLIANCE CERTIFICATE LOOK LIKE?

The gas compliance certificate comes in a triplicate book that remains the property of the licensed gas fitter. A copy of the certificate is given to the installation owner, the gas supplier and the remaining copy stays in the gas fitter's book for future reference.

## WHAT IF I DON'T HAVE A GAS COMPLIANCE CERTIFICATE OR GAS COMPLIANCE PLATE?

If you don't have a gas compliance certificate for your property, gas suppliers are legally obliged to refuse to supply your premises with gas. Supagas offers FREE gas compliance inspections to most areas in Queensland. To find out if you are eligible for a free gas compliance inspection, contact us today. This service is only available to customers who sign up for a minimum of 2 cylinders and Supagas will not reimburse the customer for the cost of the compliance certificate if the property is deemed not compliant. Any additional expenses incurred to make the premises compliant will be the responsibility of the home owner or tenant.
